

Directions to the Loess Hills Prairie Seminar and Camping Site Loess Hills Wildlife Management Area northeast of Onawa

From Onawa, travel east on Iowa Avenue (which is Iowa Highway 175).

Just east of town, turn left (north) onto County Road L-12.

Travel approximately 7.2 miles to Nutmeg Avenue and turn right (northeast).

Follow Nutmeg Avenue .4 mile to 178th Street and turn right (south).

Follow 178th Street for about 2 miles (many curves, but this will take you mostly eastward).

The Loess Hills Prairie Seminar and Camping Site is on your right, just before 178th Street's intersection with Oak Avenue.

If you have a Navigation System, you might try to enter that intersection.
